



GDPR STATEMENT – MARKE SOLUTIONS

The General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 will apply in the UK from 25th May 2018.

The GDPR offers greater protection on personal and sensitive data for all individuals.

The main enhancements are:

Increased rights to the information we hold about our customers

Information on how we keep customer data secure

Details on the type of data we collect about our customers, why we need this data, and what we use it for

How we handle your personal data

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your personal data from accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorised disclosure or access

All of your personal data is held securely in inherently secure platforms.

Our systems are all within the UK in physically secure location.

We do not share your information with anyone outside our organisation and don't have any intention of ever doing so.

We delete personal data at the end of the provision of Services except where retention is required by legal obligation or regulatory requirement

If we become aware of a personal data breach, we will notify you without undue delay

What personal data?

We only hold and use your personal data in order to fulfil a contract or to provide/purchase a service. This data might include:

Contact details

User names and password

Technical network/system details
